## THE WILDERNESS

- A time in a person's life when his or her **SOUL** is parched or dry
- When LIFE is hard
- When the FUTURE seems barren
- When as far as you can see, there is nothing but DEVASTATION
- When you wonder if there's any WAY OUT
- And you may even feel the **ABSENCE** of God's presence
- That God can use to prepare you for BLESSING and BATTLE

→ THE KEY: Don't <u>WASTE</u> your wilderness!

Life, according to the Bible, is all about RELATIONSHIPS

With **OTHERS** 

With GOD

"Live a life filled with love, following the example of Christ." EPHESIANS 5:2

"Your love for one another will prove to the world that you are my disciples." JOHN 13:25

## The ONLY WAY to walk through the wilderness is by FAITH

- → It's important to distinguish between faith and FEELINGS
- Lie: We think if we feel <u>CLOSE</u> to God, He must be close; if we feel <u>DISTANT</u>, He must be distant
- Truth: Our feelings have <u>NOTHING</u> to do with whether God is with us or not
- Our feelings are important, but they can be a bad <u>INDICATOR</u> of where we really are
- If we listen to our feelings, we will often fail to move forward with GOD

"I will never fail you. I will never abandon you." HEBREWS 13:5 [From Deuteronomy 31:6, 8]

## 1. By faith, we trust in God's PROMISES

 Faith is a decision we make <u>EVEN IF</u> we don't have all the <u>ANSWERS</u>

"And we know that God causes everything to work together for the good of those who love God and are called according to his purpose for them." ROMANS 8:28

- Faith is a decision we make often IN SPITE OF our feelings

  "For I can do everything through Christ, who gives me strength." PHILIPPIANS 4:13
- Faith is a decision we make to **RISE ABOVE** our fears

"Even though the fig trees have no blossoms, and there are no grapes on the vines; even though the olive crop fails, and the fields lie empty and barren; even though the flocks die in the fields, and the cattle barns are empty, yet I will rejoice in the LORD! I will be joyful in the God of my salvation!" HABAKKUK 3:17-18

 Faith is a decision to trust in the <u>TRUTHFULNESS</u> of God's Word

"Don't be afraid, for I am with you. Don't be discouraged, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you. I will hold you up with my victorious right hand." ISAIAH 41:10

## 2. By faith, we walk in God's PRESENCE

 Sometimes the presence of God comes upon us <u>SUDDENLY</u> and <u>UNEXPECTEDLY</u>

[Jesus] "And be sure of this: I am with you always, even to the end of the age." MATTHEW 28:20

Other times we must <u>PURPOSEFULLY</u> seek God and his presence

"Sometimes seeking and experiencing God's presence requires more than just setting aside a time and place to be alone with Him [while that is important]; it requires us to work diligently to clear our hearts and minds of all the attitudes and emotions that impede us from experiencing His presence."
