In the Bible, prophets were MESSENGERS of God

"The Bible asserts that God prepared his prophets for a very specific ministry. They brought the divine word to people who desperately needed to hear it." Bill T. Arnold

The Essence of Their Message

- A call to **REPENT** = move away from sin
- A promise of SALVATION = move toward God

"The LORD gave this message to Jonah son of Amittai: 'Get up and go to the great city of Nineveh. Announce my judgment against it because I have seen how wicked its people are.' But Jonah got up and went in the opposite direction to get away from the LORD." JONAH 1:1-3a

GOD SAID GO - JONAH SAID NO = IMMEDIATELY!

- Jonah was a prophet ON THE RUN
 - "Jonah got up and went in the opposite direction to get away from the LORD." JONAH 1:3
- Jonah was a PRAYER-LESS prophet
 - "Get up and pray to your god! Maybe he will pay attention to us and spare our lives." JONAH 1:6

Observations on Prayer from the Belly of a Fish

- 1. We can CALL on God and He will ANSWER
 - "Then Jonah prayed to the LORD his God from inside the fish. He said, 'I cried out to the LORD in my great trouble, and he answered me."' JONAH 2:1-2a
 - "So let us come boldly to the throne of our gracious God. There we will receive his mercy, and we will find grace to help us when we need it most." HEBREWS 4:16
- 2. When we need Him MOST and deserve Him LEAST, God is THERE for us

3. God often works in PHASES

"Now the LORD had arranged for a great fish to swallow Jonah. And Jonah was inside the fish for three days and three nights... As my life was slipping away, I remembered the Lord. And my earnest prayer went out to you." JONAH 1:17; 2:7

a. To get our full **ATTENTION**

"You threw me into the ocean depths, and I sank down to the heart of the sea. The mighty waters engulfed me; I was buried beneath your wild and stormy waves. Then I said, 'O LORD, you have driven me from your presence. Yet I will look once more toward your holy Temple. I sank beneath the waves, and the waters closed over me. Seaweed wrapped itself around my head. I sank down to the very roots of the mountains. I was imprisoned in the earth, whose gates lock shut forever. But you, O LORD my God, snatched me from the jaws of death!" JONAH 2:3-6

b. To get our full AFFECTION

"As my life was slipping away, I remembered the Lord. And my earnest prayer went out to you in your holy Temple." **JONAH 2:7**

c. To get our full APPRECIATION

"Those who worship false gods turn their backs on all God's mercies. But I will offer sacrifices to you with songs of praise, and I will fulfill all my vows. For my salvation comes from the Lord alone." JONAH 2:8-9a

4. **SALVATION** comes from the Lord!

"For my salvation comes from the Lord alone." Then the Lord ordered the fish to spit Jonah out onto the beach." JONAH 2:9b-10
