Habakkuk 2:4

- We can take our **struggles** straight to God (Ch. 1)
- It's okay for believers to have questions and faith simultaneously; to accept what we don't understand and trust in God despite all circumstances (Ch. 1)
- Faith often requires waiting for God's justice (Ch. 2)
- Faith comes from a **hope** based not on visible circumstances but in God, who is ultimately in control of history (Ch. 2)
- God will ultimately bring justice to His world (Ch. 3)
