THE BASICS

1. Who is God?

Answer: God is **HOLY TRINITY**; Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Three persons in one God

2. What is God like?

Answer: God is perfect in POWER, KNOWLEDGE, and in His HOLY LOVE

3. What did God make?

Answer: God spoke EVERYTHING into being, by His own FREE CHOICE, and it was VERY GOOD

4. Why is there evil?

Answer: God gave us FREE WILL to obey and we did not

5. Who is Jesus Christ?

Answer: The eternally begotten Son of God and the Son of Mary. Fully **DIVINE**. Fully **HUMAN**.

6. Why did the Son of God become human?

Who is Jesus? = God in the FLESH [Incarnation]

"The Word became human and made his home among us. He was full of unfailing love and faithfulness. And we have seen his glory, the glory of the Father's one and only Son." John 1:14

"Though he was God, he did not think of equality with God as something to cling to. Instead, he gave up his divine privileges; he took the humble position of a slave and was born as a human being. When he appeared in human form..." Philippians 2:6-7

"The incarnation is the greatest testimony to God's desire to redeem the world and to make good on his promise to Abraham to bless all the nations of the world through his offspring." Timothy Tennent

- He is Fully GOD "our LORD," the 2nd person of the Trinity
 - = He had a divine Father, divine power, and a divine will
 - = He is **HOLY**, **UNCREATED**, **ETERNAL**, **RELATIONAL**, and **LOVE**

"In the beginning the Word already existed. The Word was with God, and the Word was God. He existed in the beginning with God. God created everything through him, and nothing was created except through him." John 1:1-3

"[Jesus] The Father and I are one." John 10:30

"We look forward with hope to that wonderful day when the glory of our great God and Savior, Jesus Christ, will be revealed." Titus 2:13

- He was Fully HUMAN "His only Son," the 2nd Adam
 - = He had a human mother, human body, human will and human emotions

"The Scriptures tell us, 'The first man, Adam, became a living person.' But the last Adam—that is, Christ—is a life-giving Spirit." 1 Corinthians 15:45

"The angel replied, 'The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you. So the baby to be born will be holy, and he will be called the Son of God." Luke 1:35

"In Christ lives all the fullness of God in a human body." Colossians 2:9

- He is the LADDER between Heaven and Earth
 - = Jesus bridges the GAP between heaven and earth

"I [Jesus] tell you the truth, you will all see heaven open and the angels of God going up and down on the Son of Man, the one who is the stairway between heaven and earth." John 1:51

"This High Priest of ours understands our weaknesses, for he faced all of the same testings we do, yet he did not sin."
