	"Search me, O God, and know my heart;" V. 23a
	 David invites God to know his to examine him closely
	David for a personal, vital intimacy with God
	"The human heart is the most deceitful of all things, and desperately wicked. Who really knows how bad it is?" Jeremiah 17:9

2.	me
	"Test ("Try") me and know my anxious thoughts." V. 23b
	David invites God to know his – to put him to the test, to know his anxieties
	"What we fear the most reveals where we trust God the least." Craig Groeschel
3.	me
	"Point out anything in me that offends you" V. 24a
	David invites God to any sin, even that which he wasn't even aware of!

	"and lead me along the path of everlasting life." V. 24b
	David invites God to the entirety of his life
	"Lead me in the right path, O LORD, or my enemies will conquer me. Make your way plain for me to follow." Psalm 5:8
