Poverty in Proverbs > 100 References about Wealth & Poverty

- Many Proverbs are devoted to describing the harsh realities of poverty = its existence and its characteristics
- Many Proverbs describe the poor in contrast to the wealthy
- In Proverbs, the Hebrew word for "poor" generally refers to the lack of material and/or social resources
- Given the terrible effects and characteristics of poverty, many Proverbs contain admonitions on how to avoid it
- Many proverbs detail negative consequences and positive rewards for how the poor are treated

What does the Bible say is our responsibility to the poor?

"Those who **oppress** [actions] the poor insult their Maker, but helping the poor honors him." Proverbs 14:31

"Those who **mock** [attitude] the poor insult their Maker; those who rejoice at the misfortune of others will be punished." Proverbs 17:5

"God's people cannot be indifferent toward those in need because His expectations for us in regard to taking care of the poor are woven throughout the entirety of Scripture." GW

"Our treatment of the poor needs to be based upon the fact that they have been made in the image of God and are therefore worthy of dignity and respect. To deny them the treatment that each and every human being deserves is not just stinginess, it is an insult and an offense to the Creator... It is not enough to simply not oppress the poor. Proverbs, along with the rest of Scripture, seems to mandate advocating for their justice." Joshua Steele (author, scholar, and Anglican priest)
