What is the ONE THING, above ALL THINGS, you most want to LIVE FOR?

"1The Lord is my light and my salvation—so why should I be afraid? The Lord is my fortress, protecting me from danger, so why should I tremble? ²When evil people come to devour me, when my enemies and foes attack me, they will stumble and fall. ³Though a mighty army surrounds me, my heart will not be afraid. Even if I am attacked, I will remain confident. ⁴The one thing I ask of the Lord—the thing I seek most—is to live in the house of the Lord all the days of my life, delighting in the Lord's perfections and meditating ("seek him" – NIV; "to inquire" - NRSV) in his Temple. ⁵For he will conceal me there when troubles come; he will hide me in his sanctuary. He will place me out of reach on a high rock. ⁶Then I will hold my head high above my enemies who surround me. At his sanctuary I will offer sacrifices with shouts of joy, singing and praising the Lord with music." Psalm 27:1-6

Above all else, the Psalmist wanted to live a GOD-CENTERED LIFE, a life DIRECTED TOWARD GOD and a life ORGANIZED AROUND GOD; a life WITH God AT THE CENTER.

He was CONVINCED that this was the ONLY WAY to TRULY LIVE According to the Psalmist, a God-centered life is

- A life oriented toward the ______ of God
 In the ancient world, God's house was the Tabernacle or the Temple
 - → To worship God corporately
 - → To hear from and learn God's Word
 - → To be with God's people

In the modern world, God's house is the Church – the "ecclesia" (i.e. the "called out ones," the "gathered," or the "assembled)

- → To worship God corporately
- → To hear from and learn God's Word
- → To be with God's people

"Let us hold tightly without wavering to the hope we affirm, for God can be trusted to keep his promise. Let us think of ways to motivate one another to acts of love and good works. And let us not neglect our meeting together, as some people do, but encourage one another, especially now that the day of his return is drawing near." Hebrews 10:23-25
