- Zilpah = Leah's servant, with Jacob had 2 boys (sons 7 & 8)
- Bilhah = Rache's maid, with Jacob had 2 boys (sons 5 & 6)
- 2. Sibling jealousy, rivalry, and parental favoritism
- 3. Manipulation, unloved wives, and uncherished kids
