<sup>448</sup>This is a trustworthy saying, and I want you to insist on these teachings so that all who trust in God will devote themselves to doing good. These teachings are good and beneficial for everyone. <sup>9</sup>Do not get involved in foolish discussions about spiritual pedigrees or in quarrels and fights about obedience to Jewish laws. These things are useless and a waste of time. <sup>10</sup>If people are causing divisions among you, give a first and second warning. After that, have nothing more to do with them. <sup>11</sup>For people like that have turned away from the truth, and their own sins condemn them."
